Objectives of Gita Vision

1) Bhagavad Gita which is the essence of all scriptures should be declared as the Ultimate scripture for Hindus.

2) All Hindu temples should be brought under an independent and autonomous body like Election Commission, Judiciary, CVC, etc

3) Globally all Hindus compulsory should have one day of the week i.e. Saturday from 5 pm to 6 pm for Kirtan, Puja, Parayanam, Gita Satsang, Dhyanam and Aarati in the nearest temple conducted by Gita Vision pracharak.

4) Reforms and renovation of the present education system by teaching 50% secular education and 50% spiritual education including importance of environment should be imparted.(Spiritual Education: Important topics from Ramayanam, Mahabharatam and Bhagavad Gita;Mordern Education: Thorough understanding of Indian Constitution Acts & Laws, Science and Technology).

5) Separate Gurukulas for boys and girls should be restored and boys and girls above 9 years of age should be taught Bhagavad Gita along with Yajnopaveeta samskara, Gayatri Mantropadesha without any distinction of caste, religion, gender, language and region.

6) Provision for all kinds of assistance only to needy / deserving dharmic citizens by government and corporates should be encouraged, reservation /dole outs based on religion and ulterior motives should be removed.

7) Bhagavad Gita must be taught in public and private educational institutions and in the certificates only mention Sanatana Hindu. All students should be encouraged to excel in a vibrant, caste neutral atmosphere.

8) Sanskrit must be taught along with the mother tongue in every state. Environmental awareness / friendliness must be practiced.

9) In our culture, greetings such as mommy, daddy, aunty, uncle etc. should be avoided and kinship titles / greetings should be in mother tongue. Meaning / importance of the festivals should be imparted onto society and then the rituals should be followed. Both men and women must wear tilak of sandalwood / vibhuti / Kumkum. Pub culture should be banned.

10) Brothers and sisters who have gone away from Sanatana Dharma to other religious beliefs and faiths or are drifting away from Sanatana Dharma, should be made aware of the greatness / uniqueness / vibrancy / inclusivity of Sanatana Dharma and should be warmly welcomed back into Sanatana Hindu Dharma.

11) The entire family should provide a spiritual, harmonious, vibrant, clean atmosphere with special care for pregnant women, thus benefit for society will be enormous (for eg:- Subhadra : Abhimanyu; Madalasa; Lilavathi : Prahlada etc.).

12) The Uniform Civil Code (UCC) contained in the Constitution should be implemented immediately so as to provide social equality and justice to everyone in this country.

13) Introducing Gita Dhiksha 41 days prior to Gita Jayanti, open to all without any discrimination whoever having earnest Shradha & Bhakti towards Krishna/Gita.

14) Ancient temples which have been neglected should be identified and their glory should be restored. It should be ensured that Nitya Pooja, parayanam, Satsangs are held in those temples according to the Gita Vision Pooja process. New temples should be built only if the long term maintenance according to shastras can be ensured.

15) Gita Vision Pooja Process :-

- 1. Kirtan 5 minutes
- 2. Pooja 5 minutes
- 3. Recitation 10 minutes
- 4. Geetha Vision Satsang 30 minutes
- 5. Meditation and Aarati 10 minutes

In every temple regular puja should be modified to GITA VISION pooja process.



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
